

# 2022 DEMOGRAPHICS REPORT



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# OVERVIEW

The San Francisco Health Service System (SFHSS) administers non-pension benefits (including health, dental and vision, employer paid life and LTD) and other voluntary benefits. Our membership is comprised of employees and retirees of the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF), the San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD), City College of San Francisco (SFCCD) and the Superior Court of San Francisco (CRT), as well as eligible dependents. This report is based on SFHSS membership demographics as of January 1, 2022.

## Medical Enrollment

Plan Year 2022 introduced two new medical plans to SFHSS members: Health Net CanopyCare HMO and Blue Shield of California PPO-Accolade, which replaced UnitedHealthcare PPO (City Plan). Health Net features five major medical groups with a large network of physicians, contracted hospitals/medical centers, and urgent care centers across nine Bay Area counties. Blue Shield PPO-Accolade allows you to see any doctor you choose and pay less for most services by network providers, self-refer to specialists and access an Accolade Health Assistant and nurse for personalized support of your health needs.

### Dental Enrollment

SFHSS administers dental plans for employees and dependents of the City and County of San Francisco and Superior Court of San Francisco, as well as retirees from all employers. Dental benefits for employees are employer-subsidized. Retiree dental plan premiums are paid 100% by the retiree. In 2022, the overall count of enrolled lives decreased by 847 lives.

### Flexible Spending Accounts

Flexible Spending Accounts are IRS-approved, tax-favored accounts that allow employees to reduce out-of-pocket costs for qualified medical, child care and dependent care expenses. The significant increase in enrollment was aided in part by IRS approved 2021 mid-year IRS dependent care changes and targeted outreach performed by SFHSS.

Voluntary benefits premiums are 100% paid for by the employee and deducted from employee’s pay checks.


The Hartford Supplemental Term Life Insurance is the benefit with the largest number of members at 3,775 and saw an increase of 618 enrollments from last year.



# ENROLLED LIVES

## All Employee and Retiree Members and Dependents

- Enrollment in medical coverage decreased for the second year in a row from 124,069 lives to 122,250, a decrease of 1,819 lives.
- 37% of the lives (45,695) covered under SFHSS medical plans reside in San Francisco, which is the county with the largest percentage of SFHSS lives.
- Percentage distribution of member lives by geography among the largest Bay Area counties included San Mateo with 19% (23,547) of members, Contra Costa at 12% (14,672), followed by Alameda with 11% (13,092) and Solano (4,589) and Marin (4,583) counties tied for the fifth largest counties with 4% of SFHSS membership respectively.
- The proportion of employee to retiree lives enrolled in medical coverage remained the same as last year with employees representing 67% and retirees representing 33% of total lives.
- SFHSS has 6,934 employee members and 5,458 retiree members who elected to waive medical coverage for plan year 2022.
- In 2020, there was a steep decline in hires which was greater than the terminations. In 2021 the new hires/rehires increased but are still considerably lower than 2019 levels which is a contributing factor in the overall decrease of lives.

5 Year Trend Hires, Retirements, and Terminations





**Employees:**

- Employee members represent 81,532 of total lives, which includes 40,029 members and 41,503 dependents, of which 26,562 are children and 14,941 are adults.
- The total number of employee members enrolled in dental coverage decreased slightly from 31,870 to 31,740 or 130 lives. The total number of employee lives, which includes dependents, enrolled in dental coverage is 72,343, down from 73,898 last year.
- The number of employee members that waived dental coverage in 2022 increased to 1,730 from 1,718 last year.


**Retirees:**

- The total number of retiree members enrolled in dental coverage increased from 23,274 to 24,515 or 1,241 lives. The total number of retiree lives, including dependents, enrolled in dental coverage is 35,111, an increase from 33,548, or 1,563 lives from last year.
- The number of retiree members that waived dental coverage in 2022 decreased to 9,148 from 9,182 last year.


Medical Enrollment: All Covered Lives



■ Members ■ Dependents


Average Age by Plan: All Covered Lives


# EMPLOYEE AND RETIREE MEMBERS

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
## Employee and Retiree Members For All City Employers

- As of January 2022, a total of 70,225 members were enrolled, a decrease of 580 enrollees. SFHSS active employee members decreased for the second year in a row by 858 to 40,029 and retirees increased enrollment by 278 to 30,196 members.
- The number of active and retiree members enrolled in Kaiser Permanente HMO plans decreased for a second year in a row by 510 members but remains the carrier with the largest portion, 51%, of all member enrollment.
- In 2022, Blue Shield of California PPO-Accolade replaced UnitedHealthcare PPO (City Plan) as SFHSS' PPO plan administrator and has 1,850 members. There is no Medicare option in the Blue Shield PPO. Therefore, SFHSS members who have Medicare dependents can enroll in the UHC Companion plan PPO / UHC Medicare Advantage PPO. This plan is only available to split Medicare families.
- UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage PPO saw an increase of 217 members to 13,573.
- 25,489 members have a spouse and 1,497 members have a domestic partner enrolled in medical benefits.
- 58% of employee and retiree members are enrolled in member-only coverage (40,405), 26% are enrolled in member plus one dependent (18,033), and 17% enrolling in member plus two or more dependents (11,787).


Medical Enrollment: Employee vs. Retiree Members




Average Age by Medical Plan: Employee and Retiree Members



Medical Enrollment by Gender: Employee and Retiree Members




Medical Enrollment: Employees vs. Retirees Within Each Plan



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## Employees and Dependents (All Employers)


- The number of employee lives covered by SFHSS medical plans decreased from last year with 81,532 (from 83,804), a difference of 2,272.
- The proportion of employees vs. dependents enrolled in medical coverage has remained the same since 2017, with 51% employee members and 49% employee dependents.
- Kaiser Permanente's proportional share of all employee lives has remained at 61% for the past three years.
- Employees and dependents enrolled in Blue Shield of California's Trio HMO and Access+ HMO plans account for 12% and 24% of employee lives respectively. The new Blue Shield PPO-Accolade plan, which replaces UnitedHealthcare PPO (City Plan) represents 2% or 1,696 employee lives.
- Enrollment in the new Health Net CanopyCare HMO debuted at 315 lives or <1% of total employee lives enrolled in medical plans.
- 25% of employee members (10,145) have one dependent enrolled in coverage and 28% (11,430) have two or more dependents enrolled.
- 40% of employee members, with or without dependents, live in San Francisco County, which is the same as last year followed by San Mateo County with 20%.
- The most significant change in distribution of benefit eligible employees by race/ethnicity from 2021 was a decrease of the percentage of Hispanic employees from 14.39% to 13.86%. The percentage of Black employees decreased from 13.2% to 13.13%, White employees increased from 33.2% to 33.6%, Asian employees changed from 27.4% to 27.5% and percent distribution of Filipino employees was unchanged. Race/Ethnicity data is not available for all employees. In the graph the percentages are represented in whole numbers for readability.

Employees by Race/Ethnicity\*




Medical Enrollment: Employees vs. Dependents



Medical Enrollment by Gender: Employees and Dependents




Average Age by Medical Plan: Employees and Dependents


## Retiree Members and Dependents (All Employers)

- Total medically enrolled Retiree lives increased by 453 lives to 40,718 from 40,265. Retiree members increased by 278 and retiree dependents increased by 148.
- The percentage of retirees vs. dependents enrolled in medical remained the same as last year with 74% retiree members and 26% retiree dependents.
- 13,573 Medicare-eligible retirees enrolled in UHC Medicare Advantage PPO and 11,174 retirees enrolled in Kaiser Permanente Senior Advantage.
- 60 eligible non-Medicare retiree lives transitioned into UnitedHealthcare PPO Companion Plan and 1,101 moved to the new Blue Shield of California PPO-Accolade plan.
- The average age of Medicare retiree lives enrolled in medical coverage is 74.93 and the average age of Non-Medicare retiree lives is 53.15.
- The number of retiree members and dependents enrolled in coverage who reside outside of the United States is 53. 90 members living outside of the United States have waived coverage.
- California continues to have the highest number of retirees and dependents enrolled at 92% (37,356). 13,090, or 35% of retirees live in San Francisco.




Medical Enrollment by Coverage Level: Retirees



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
## Employers

- Of 122,250 total lives, the City and County of San Francisco has the largest percentage of active and retiree lives at 81.9%. The San Francisco Unified School District has 13.9% followed by City College of San Francisco at 3.1% and the Superior Court of San Francisco with 1.1%.
- Of the total number of lives by employer, the proportion of retiree lives to active employees is: 46.19% for City College of San Francisco, 42.1% for Superior Court of San Francisco, 32.2% for City and County of San Francisco, and San Francisco Unified School District with 36.1%.
- SFUSD has the highest proportion of employee lives enrolled in Kaiser Permanente HMO, compared to other employers. 72% of SFUSD, a steady 58% for City and County of San Francisco, and slightly lower enrollments for Superior Court employees at 46%, and 56% of City College of San Francisco employee lives.
- For all employers, the average age of lives is highest for City College of San Francisco at 57.48 years and lowest for City and County of San Francisco at 46.03 years. The average age for the San Francisco Unified School District is 52.46 and the Superior Court of San Francisco is 50.94.
- City and County of San Francisco decreased total number of lives enrolled in medical plans from 101,235 in 2021 to 101,101 in 2022.
- Across the board, enrollment coverage of families decreased from 2021. All categories of dependent coverage experienced a 2-4% decrease: spouse or domestic partner only, children only, or spouse/domestic partner and children. This decrease was observed both in employee members and retiree members.

Medical Enrollment: Retiree vs. Employee Lives




Medical Enrollment: All Lives by Employer

# GLOSSARY

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- **Lives/Covered Lives:** The Plan subscribers (active and retired employees) and their covered dependents.
- **Employee Members:** The Plan subscriber who is an active employee.
- **Retiree Members:** The Plan subscriber who is a retired employee.
- **Retiree Non-Medicare:** Retired employee or their dependent who is not eligible for Medicare or eligible but not enrolled in Medicare.
- **Medicare Retiree:** Retired employee or their dependent(s) who is enrolled in Medicare.
- **Dependents:** Children, Spouse, Domestic Partner.
- **Member:** The Plan subscriber. When not itemized, this includes both active and retired employee.
- **Employers:** Four organizations whose health benefits are administered by the San Francisco Health Service System (SFHSS):
  1. **City and County of San Francisco (CCSF)**
  2. **Superior Court of San Francisco (CRT)**
  3. **City College of San Francisco (SFCCD)**
  4. **San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD)**

Due to HIPAA, health enrollment numbers which are less than a count of 26 have been suppressed. Because of masking of numbers, totals and percentages will not add to the grand totals across the report.
