Requested Topics for 2026

The Commissioners and SFHSS leadership partner each year to provide educational opportunities that enhance continuous learning. The Education Plan guides the SFHSS Leadership team in creating a list of educational topics, offering educational resources, and delivering Subject Matter Expert (SME) presentations to the Board throughout the year. Commissioners completed the annual Board Education survey to request topics for 2026.

- The role of AI in provider decision making. For example- WISeR (Wasteful and Inappropriate Service Reduction) model
- More Fiduciary responsibilities.
- Intro to AI potential in the health insurance and healthcare space. A wide topic, but it would be important for us as a Board to understand its current use (by payors), and its future potential use to improve care and lower costs.
- Education to better understand the relationship between Medicare and our insurance providers.
- Effects on healthcare costs as a result of using drugs for off-label use (e.g., GLP-1s) and strategies to address.
- Update on new or revised State or Federal regulation changes to healthcare coverages.
